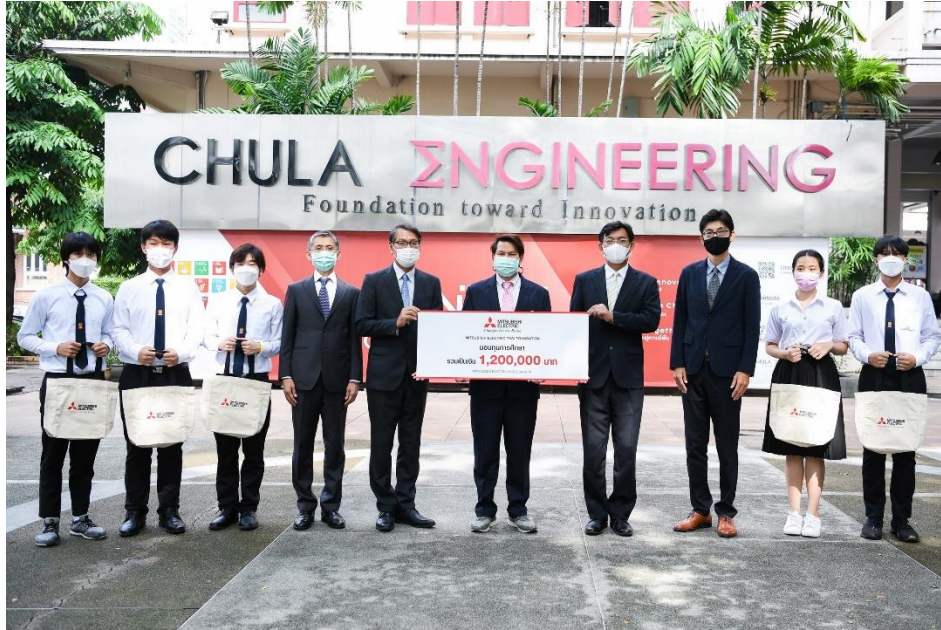
### **Mitsubishi Electric Thai Foundation Offers 1.2 Million Baht in Scholarships** **To Support Education for Engineering Students**
