Darussalam and Timor-Leste as the two lowest ranking ASEAN teams will playoff in home and

away matches on October 8th and 15th for a place in the main competition. The second

playoff match on October 15th will be held in Chonburi Stadium in Chonburi.

In an Official Draw in May this year, The ten qualifying teams were drawn into two groups of five for the

round-robin group stage matches which will be played on a home or away basis. The top two

finishers of each group advance to the double legged home-and-away semi-finals and subsequently,

the two winners battle for the championship title at the finals.
